
ICT & IT LABORATORY

ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

For B.Ed. - Candidate must be Bachelor Degree/Master Degree in any discipline (Science / Arts / Commerce, B.Tech/BBA/MBA) from any recognized university with minimum 50% marks for General and 45% for SC/ST/OBC Candidates.

For D.El. Ed. - Candidate must be passed in 10+2 / Intermediate in Science / Arts / Commerce from any recognized school / college with minimum 50% marks for General and 45% for SC/ST/OBC Candidates.

STRUCTURE OF COURSES

Both the programmes are essentially a judicious mix of theory and practical courses to develop knowledge, skills and attitude in practising teachers. Illustrations and cases of relevant situations and activities comprise the core of each course.

DURATION OF COURSES

The duration of Course is two year Academic Session. There shall be at least two hundred working days in each year excluding the period of Admission & Examination. Every trainee shall be required to undergo teaching practice & skill development.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications form can be obtained from the college office personally / by sending the crossed Demand Draft (preferably) in favour of Scholar B.Ed. College payable at Giridih. It is to be duly filled in by the candidate and submitted to the College office along with all relevant documents such as:-

- a) Self attested photocopy of the Matriculation Mark sheet & Certificate.
- b) Self attested photocopy of the mark sheet of Senior Secondary Exam
- c) Self attested photocopy of the mark sheet of Graduation / Post-Graduation (not applicable for D.El.Ed.)
- d) Original College Leaving Certificate/Department Leaving Certificate (at the time of Admission)
- e) Original migration certificate
- f) 5 stamp size & 5 Passport size recent color photograph.
- g) Two self addressed and stamped (Rs. 40/-) envelop for correspondence.
- h) Attested photocopy of Caste certificate and Residential certificate issued by authority not below the rank of SDO.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

The selection of the candidate for admission in B.Ed. & D.El.Ed. Course will be done strictly in accordance with the merit list prepared on the basis of the rules and regulations laid down by the state government and affiliating bodies. List of selected candidates will be displayed on the college notice board. The selected candidates are required to take admission within the stipulated time in case of failing, the seat would be offered to the next candidate in the waiting list. GENERAL RULES AND REGULATION

Keeping in view the aims and aspirations of Scholar B.Ed. College certain rules and regulations have been framed to be strictly followed by trainees. These rules have been formulated not to bind the trainees within the premises but to make them understand the value and standard of discipline which, when followed meticulously by the trainees, help them to emerge into a more determined, matured and knowledgeable individual. A whole hearted support from out trainees and guardians are thus solicited.

- 1. Students shall strictly comply with the rules and regulations of the college issued from time to time relating to their studies, examinations conduct and discipline.
- 2. The students, who secure admission on the basis of false certificate / marks sheet on the basis of any misrepresentation of facts or illegal means, shall be summarily cancelled and all fees paid by him/her shall be forfeited. Legal action shall also be taken against them.
- 3. Candidates are required to enclose along with their application, an affidavit before a Notary Public stating that all information given by them are true.
- 4. Application accompanied with requisite documents/enclosure received after the last date shall be summarily rejected.
- 5. No refund of fees under any circumstances will be made on the withdrawal of the admission.
- 6. In case the candidate fails to submit the required documents admission shall be treated as cancelled and no request for refund of fees will be entertained under any circumstances.
- 7. If the applicant is employed, employers no objection certificate with proof of two year leave must be submitted during the time of admission.
- 8.Trainees can avail all facilities only after the course commences and only till the course is completed.
- 9. Trainees are liable to security checks on entry or exit from the college premises.
- 10. Institution will not be responsible for any loss of belongings left unattended by the trainees at the college premises.
- 11. Intake of any sort of intoxicating substance is strictly prohibited. Chewing of Paan/Gutka/Chewing Gum is also prohibited.
- 12. A trainee has to ensure at least 80% attendance for attaining eligibility for appearing at the university examination.
- 13. A medical certificate will be required if there are more than three days consecutive absence owing to illness.
- 14. All Institution's property have to handled with care. Any damage or pilferage caused to Institution's property by any trainee will be appropriately charged.


- 15. Trainees should strictly adhere to instructions regarding entry/exit regulations, parking of vehicles etc. They should not bring friends, visitors or relatives to the class rooms or practical rooms or in the college campus.
- 16. Ragging is banned in the Institution and any one indulging in ragging process is likely to be punished appropriately.
- 17. All trainees are supposed to attend the classes in proper uniform specified for them.
- 18. Male trainees must have short and properly groomed hair, clean ans well trimmed nails. They should attend classes every day with a clean shave and polished shoe.
- 19. Female trainees must have properly groomed hair, clean and well trimmed nails.
- 20. During class hours wearing the college Identity Card is compulsory.
- 21. These rules come into effect immediately and equally apply on all trainees of the Institution.
- 22. Institution holds the right to introduce, alter, amend or change only or all the rules from time to time if found necessary.
- 23. Interpretation of these rules will always be made by the designated persons of the Institution and shall be final and binding on all trainees.
- 24. For any legal dispute the jurisdiction will be at Giridih Court only.
- 25. Discontinuance:
- (i) In case any trainee is found not paying his/her fees within 20 days from the due date he / she will fetch strong disciplinary measures.
- (ii) If any trainee at their own opt to drop out from the course then the case will also be treated a discontinuance. In such a situation, the course fee and other charges already paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.
- (iii) In case of absence for 15 consecutive days, the college must be informed of valid reason or the case will be treated as discontinuance.
- (iv) In case of misconduct and violation of college norm, trainees may fetch disciplinary action leading to discontinuance.


